Romania - Summer 2024

Europe Ministry Tour - Summer 2024

Calvary Boise has a history of ministry in Europe that started with several short-term mission trips back in the 1990's and early 2000's. As a result of these trips, we've seen missionaries sent and churches planted around the world. In 2023, we sensed it was time for a new generation to have the benefit of touring Europe, serving with our mission partners, and considering the call of God in their lives. That trip bore fruit in many of the lives of those who went on the trip. We believe the same will happen in 2024. This trip will visit and serve our partners in Slovenia and the Basque country, Spain, while continuing to explore how we can work with new partners in Northern Italy. There are also possible excursions to France and England that are in the works depending on the needs of ministries we are in contact with. The opportunities abound, including outreach events, a Lego camp for kids, youth events, work projects, and more. You can sign up for the whole tour of approximately four to six weeks or narrow your focus to coming on a 10-day trip to Slovenia, Northern Italy, or Spain. One of the exciting opportunities with this trip is the possibility to plan to serve in Europe for an extended month in August, either pre-planned or decided while on the trip.

Over the last year, as we were discerning the next steps for our body, we were regularly looking at our own processes and procedures.
