

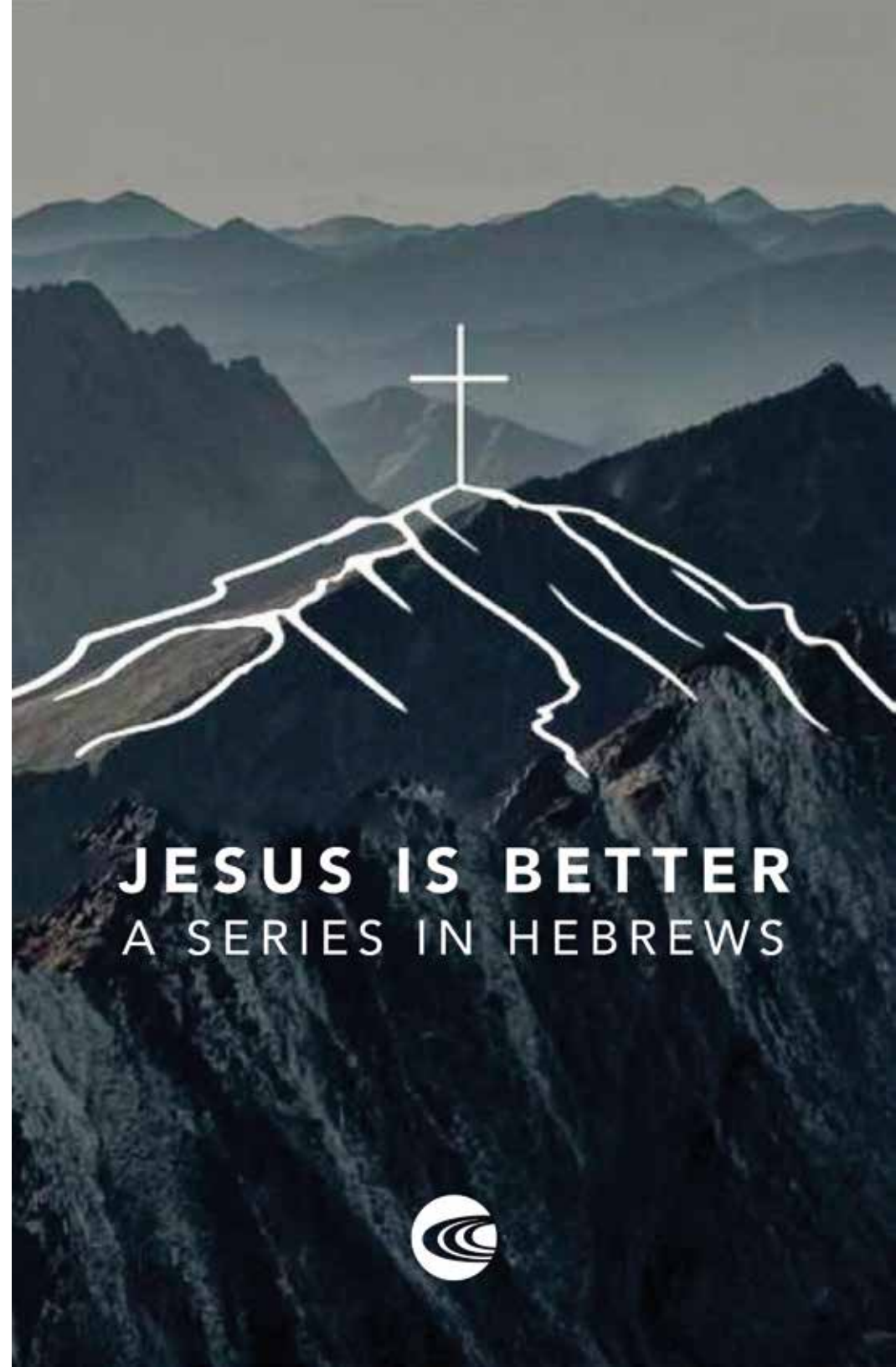

## A Note From The Pastor

Dear Church Family

I am so thankful for the ways in which we are becoming family together! As I've been meeting with people in the church, continuing to grow with the elders, and taking time to review the various ministries in the church, I see a community that is seeking more than a Sunday worship gathering. I see a people that want to live life together as a community.

This is so encouraging because I believe that is in the image of our triune God. This Sunday is "Trinity Sunday" celebrated in various Christian traditions. This is a day to recognize that God is a Trinity. He is one God yet eternally exists in three persons—The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Each person of the Trinity is fully God. As a community within Himself, God has always existed in loving communion. He did not need to create anyone or anything in order to be loving. This is why I find the ways we are living as a community so encouraging! I say praise God, and also thank you for continuing to grow into this type of community.

In our service today we will take time to acknowledge Trinity Sunday, by reading a call and response abbreviated version of the Athanasian creed. Athanasius was an early "church father" as a pastor who put Trinitarian thought into a creed very early in church history. I recommend reading the whole creed sometime this Sunday as a family or in your growth group this week. Here is an article on it to check out as well.



### RESPONSIVE READING

We worship one God in trinity and the trinity in unity. The person of the Father is a distinct person,

**ALL: the person of the Son is another, and that of the Holy Spirit still another**

But the divinity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one. Their glory equal; their majesty co-eternal.

**ALL: What quality the Father has, the Son has, and the Holy Spirit has. The Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, the Holy Spirit is uncreated. The Father is immeasurable, the Son is immeasurable, the Holy Spirit is immeasurable. The Father is eternal, the Son is eternal, the Holy Spirit is eternal.**

And yet there are not three eternal beings. There is but one eternal being. So too there are not three uncreated or immeasurable beings. There is but one uncreated and immeasurable being.

**ALL: The Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, the Holy Spirit is almighty. Yet there are not three almighty beings. There is but one almighty being. Thus the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God. Yet there are not three gods. There is but one God.**
