We've been going through community

life on Wednesday nights as we study how to be a biblical community together. I Peter 2:5 says, "You yourselves are like living stones being built up as a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." I love the imagery that the church, in a sense, is the new temple, all of us are stones built together to be where the praise of God dwells in our lives, connected together. Like it says in the verse, you're being built up as a spiritual house. This takes time. The community of Christ is always being built together, and Jesus is the one who builds His church. He's bringing stone upon stone. He's refining and shaping each stone, and then, He's putting us together.

One way that that happens is by getting to know each others' stories.
