As we continue to meditate on Jesus' first coming (advent) and wait expectantly for his second advent, I am truly thankful for the gift we have received in the person and work of Jesus. I pray as we continue to reflect on this gift in the hues of love, hope, joy and peace, that our hearts will be renewed in God's grace for the coming year. This past Wednesday we closed out our Wednesday Community Life nights for the fall, and had a brief church family meeting.

If you weren't there, I wanted to update you on a couple things. First, this Christmas Eve, we will have the joy of a shared gathering with New City Church. Our Christmas Eve service will be at 4:30 P.M. and be a wonderful time of celebration of the gift of God's light to us in Christ.
