

A Note From The Pastor

Dear Cole Community Church,

We're excited to share an update on our journey to merge and form a new church in partnership with New City Church.

The elder teams from both our churches met last week and voted enthusiastically to continue to move forward with this process to become a new church together. As we look ahead to our next steps, we want to begin to provide a framework for what we hope this new church will become.

In an effort to communicate this well, Pastors Kirk & Josh (New City) have filmed a 34 minute video encompassing the following: a recap of the merger talks, how this new work will be strengthened by being inter-generational and with a fuller staff team, A new name for this new work, how we have received help and will be proceeding with help through church networks, and a section on our next steps. We have placed "chapters" in the video so that you can watch parts that interest you particularly, but want to encourage all our church family to watch the whole thing. That video is available in our weekly email this week or on our Youtube page.

After you've had a chance to watch the video we'd appreciate it if you could take just a few minutes to fill out a short online form to help us get a better sense of your interest and engagement as we move forward in this process.
